

## Pool Rules

**Do to an inordinate number of non-residents claiming to live in the neighborhood, taking all of the lounge chairs and dominating the diving board we need to address these issues ASAP. The pool staff, management and committee are working to keep The Knolls pool a great part of the neighborhood. We welcome all of your cooperation and assistance in policing the area.**

Do not enter the pool area without a lifeguard staff member on duty. All residents must sign in at each visit to the pool. Include names of children and guests in attendance.

Emergency cards must be on file for every Knolls family.

1. No running, pushing, or boisterous play in the pool area.
2. Non-swimmers must remain in the shallow water. "Swimmies" or "Floaties" are not lifesaving devices. Children may not be in the pool without direct supervision.
3. No bottles, glass, or sharp objects within the fenced area surrounding the pool.
4. No food in pool; restrict to lounging areas.
5. The baby pool is for children under 6. They must be accompanied by an adult or babysitter.
6. Children under 9 must be accompanied by an adult or babysitter of at least 12 years of age. Lifeguards reserve the right to ask a baby sitter to take his/her charges home if their behaviors become unmanageable.
7. Children 9 or over may attend the pool without an adult only when able to swim the length of the pool.
8. Guests must be accompanied by a Knolls resident. Adults should limit their guests to two adults and their children.
9. Each child of a homeowner is allowed one non-resident guest
10. Floation items are restricted to the shallow end of the pool.
11. Suspension of pool privileges may be a result of acts of vandalism or repeated misbehaviors.
12. Swimmers may not swim under or near the diving board. Divers are requested to swim immediately to either side of the pool, and not back towards the diving board.
13. No double jumping or running is allowed on the diving board.
14. All residents and guests must obey weather warnings by the lifeguards, specifically lightning and thunder warnings must be adhered to.

Babysitters at the Pool:

Babysitters must be 12 or older. Number of children per sitter should be within managerial skill level of the sitter. Lifeguards may ask a sitter to take children home if their behavior is unmanageable. The pool staff will send children under 9 without supervision home.

Pool Parties:

The pool can be reserved for after-hours pool parties.

No adult pool parties may be scheduled before 8:00 p.m. Parties scheduled during regular pool hours will be asked to leave. A minimum 7 days advance notice on party bookings; all bookings must be made through either lifeguards or by calling Had at Perfect Pools, (303) 795-1191. Do NOT call Pool Committee, Knolls Board members or Clubhouse committee members for reservations!

1. A minimum of 2 staff member lifeguards must be hired at \$25 per guard.
2. A Knolls resident adult (the homeowner) must be in attendance.

3. Parents of young children wishing to hold birthday parties at the pool during pool hours must notify the pool management company in advance so that the lifeguard staff can be notified. Attendance must be within reason and include mostly Knolls children.
4. A parent must be present.

\*reserving the clubhouse does not also reserve the pool, a separate reservation must be made with Had at Perfect Pools if your party intends on entering the gated pool area

#### Use of Poolside Gas Grill:

A gas grill is available for your use by the pool. Please take advantage of this opportunity to enjoy a relaxing meal with your family by the pool. The guards will be happy to roll the grill out at any time. We ask only that you clean the grill and utensils after each use. An extra tank of gas is available should you run out. Please notify the Pool Committee if a tank of gas runs out when you are using it, so that we can refill it. The gas grill is for poolside use only and may not be used outside of the pool area or after pool hours by homeowners who have reserved the clubhouse.

#### Vandalism:

The pool management will deal with acts of vandalism on an individual basis. Pool privileges may be suspended for the remainder of the season. Parents are asked to remind their children that throwing trash or spitballs in the bathrooms is considered pool vandalism and subject to the same discipline.

#### Trespassing Policy:

Any person found trespassing in the pool area after hours will be prosecuted. A letter to this effect is on file with the Arapahoe County Sheriff.

#### Emergency Card /Consent Form:

The emergency card/consent form **MUST** be on file at the pool before any family members are admitted.

#### Use of the Pool

The Knolls pool is only for use by Knoll residences and their guests. **Anyone else is trespassing.** The Knolls does not sell memberships to any of the Knolls facilities.
